জাতীয় সামাজিক সুরক্ষা প্রকল্পের অধীনে বি পি এল পরিবার ভুক্ত বার্ষিক্য ভাতা, বিধবা ভাতা, ও প্রতিবন্ধী ভাতা এবং জাতীয় পরিবার সহায়তা প্রকল্প বর্তমানে চালু আছে। বার্ষিক্য ভাতার উপভোক্তার বয়স ৬০ বৎসর ও তার উর্দে, বিধবা ভাতার উপভোক্তার বয়স ৪০ বৎসর ও তার উর্দে, প্রতিবন্ধী ভাতার উপভোক্তার বয়স ১৮ বৎসর ও তার উর্দে, এবং জাতীয় পরিবার সহায়তা প্রকল্পে (উপভোক্তা কে) পরিবারের একমাত্র উপার্জনকারীর বয়স ৬০ বৎসরের নিচে মৃত্যু হলে তবেই উপভোক্তা আবেদন করতে পারবে। আমাদের বিধাননগর পৌর নিগমে বর্তমানে বার্ষিক্য ভাতার উপভোক্তা ১৩৫৪ জন, বিধবা ভাতার উপভোক্তা ১৮৯২ জন ও প্রতিবন্ধী ভাতার উপভোক্তা ৫৫ জন, মোট ৩৩০১ জন প্রতিমাসে ১০০০/- টাকা করে পেয়ে থাকেন। এবং জাতীয় পরিবার সহায়তা প্রকল্পে ২০২৫-২০২৬ অর্থবর্ষে বিভিন্ন ওয়ার্ডে মোট ৪ জন উপভোক্তাকে এককালীন ৪০,০০০/- টাকা করে মোট ১,৬০,০০০/- টাকা প্রদান করা হয়েছে। তাছাড়া সচেতনতা বৃদ্ধির জন্য সমস্ত ওয়ার্ডে প্রচারপত্র বিলি করা হয়েছে।
